
ORDER

Now before the Court is the Petition to Amend Rule 12 of the Mississippi Rules of Discipline for the Mississippi Bar Which Addresses Reinstatement of Disbarred Attorneys Who Have Been Convicted of Certain Types of Felonies, filed by the Mississippi Bar. The Court has hereto for published this petition and invited comments from the members of the Bar and from the public. Having received numerous comments, the undersigned Chief Justice finds that it is now appropriate that the matter be set for oral argument before the Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that oral argument on Petition to Amend Rule 12 of the Mississippi Rules of Discipline for the Mississippi Bar Which Addresses Reinstatement of Disbarred Attorneys Who Have Been Convicted of Certain Types of Felonies, filed by the Mississippi Bar, shall be held in the courtroom of the Supreme Court on February 7, 2002 at 9:30 a.m. True copies of this order shall be mailed to the Mississippi Bar and to each person who has filed a letter of comment on the matter. This order shall also

be published on the Court's web site, and those wishing to be heard in support or against the petition shall notify the Clerk of the Supreme Court in writing no later than January 28, 2002. The number of participants may be limited by the time available.
