


YOUTHS AGED OUT OF THE YOUTH COURT REPORT

(REVISED 12/14/2011)

The purpose of this report is to provide a list of youths that have attained the age of twenty but still have open cases in MYCIDS.



The Youths Aged Out of the Youth Court Report can be run by selecting the desired County or Jurisdiction. If multiple jurisdictions (ie: Judicial districts) are selected, each jurisdiction will be displayed in a separate section. Courts can only see reports for the county or districts in which they have jurisdiction.

REFERRAL TYPE BY CODE

The Youths Aged Out of the Youth Court Report is divided into sections for each youth listed on the report. The name and current age of the youth is listed at the top of the section (Figure 2, Yellow). The Docket information column lists the AOC and Universal Case Identification (UCID) numbers (Figure 2, Blue). The User may use the UCID number to search for and close the cases listed.



Each section includes a total number of cases that need to be closed for that individual (Figure 2, Green). The total number of cases listed on the report is displayed at the bottom of the page.
