The Clerk is further authorized and directed to begin exclusive use of the MEC system as the official system for case docketing in the Chancery Court of Prentiss County and to maintain any and all books and dockets utilizing the MEC system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as of September 1, 2022, the Clerk of this Court is authorized and directed to cease the current maintenance of paper files for all MEC cases, except as required by the Administrative Procedures for the Mississippi Electronic Courts adopted by this Court.
